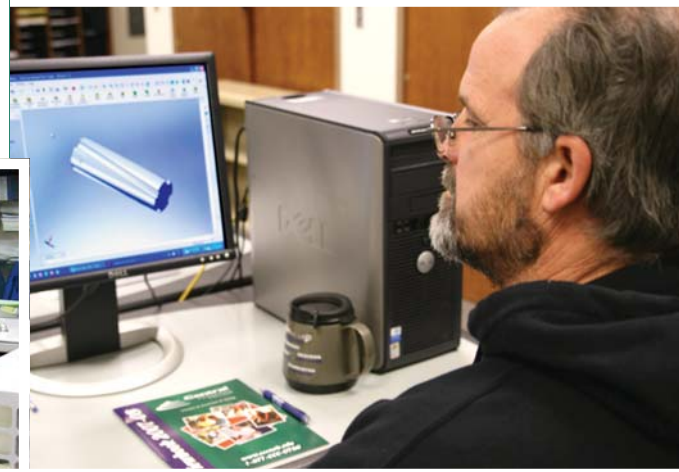


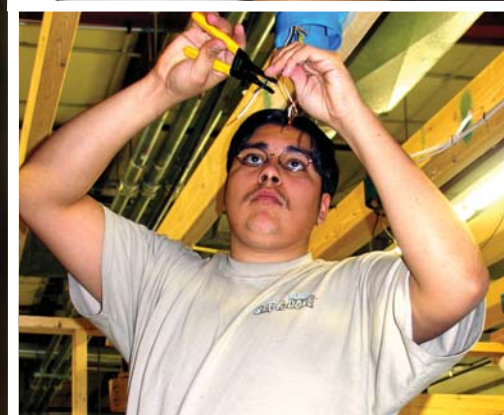

Central Community College 2007-08 Graduate Report

The 2007-08 CCC Graduate Employment Report shows that our alumni continue to do well in pursuing their post-CCC interests. Graduates of our career and technical education programs are doing well in the job market and our academic transfer graduates are successful as they continue their education at four-year colleges.

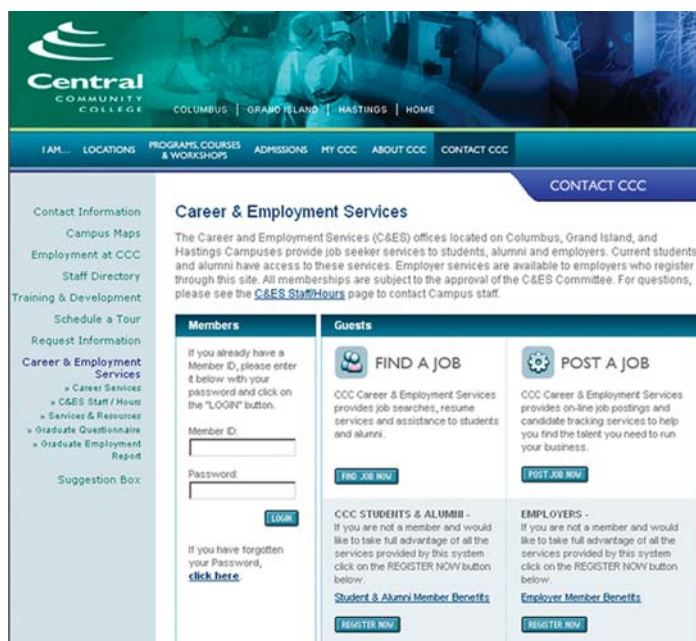

2007-08 Highlights

- ✓ 1,604 vocational awards (degrees, diplomas, certificates) were granted.
- ✓ 130 academic transfer degrees were granted.
- ✓ 95% of the graduates surveyed responded.
- ✓ 98% of the graduates who responded were employed or continuing their education at Central Community College or other institutions.
- ✓ 81% of the respondents who were either employed or continuing their education remained in the Central Community College area.
- ✓ 98% of the graduates remained in Nebraska.

Interviewing Tips

- ✓ Arrive 10 minutes early.
- ✓ Never take anyone with you.
- ✓ Treat everyone you meet with respect.
- ✓ Do not take your cell phone.
- ✓ Give a firm handshake.
- ✓ Be positive and enthusiastic.
- ✓ Listen carefully.
- ✓ Remember to smile.
- ✓ Focus on your accomplishments.
- ✓ Do not ask about salary.
- ✓ Do not discuss personal issues.
- ✓ Be prepared with questions to ask the interviewer(s).
- ✓ Thank the interviewer(s) for the opportunity to interview for the position.
- ✓ Follow up with a thank you letter.

Student/Graduate Services

Central Community College Career and Employment Services offices provide a connecting point between graduates and employers. CES offices maintain information regarding full- and part-time jobs for current students as well as graduates. The CES offices help students prepare for the job search and develop credential files. On-campus interviews can be arranged for the convenience of employers and students. Services are available to current students and alumni at no charge.

While the Career and Employment Services offices assist students in their job search, it ultimately is each student's responsibility to find and secure employment.

Employment Services

Registration for Career and Employment Services. Easy registration for services is available, as well as assistance with online registration with local Nebraska Workforce Development offices.

Job Listings. Many employers list job openings each week. Full-time, part-time, temporary and volunteer positions are listed on the job board located on each campus and on our Web site: www.cccneb.edu/ces. For application information on the jobs found on job boards, take the job number to the Career and Employment Services office on your campus or call with the job number to get more information.



Online Services. CCC students and graduates can register as members of the CES online employment service (www.cccneb.edu/ces). Registered users will be able to utilize full benefits of the system including:

- ✓ Search and obtain contact information on jobs.
- ✓ Create and post their resume for employers to view.
- ✓ Save specific jobs of interest within their own member account, using "My Saved Jobs."

Job Search Assistance

Assistance with resume preparation and critiquing, cover letter writing, interviewing techniques and job search guidance is available.

Credential File Service

Graduates (diploma and degree) are encouraged to establish a credential file during the last semester before graduation. The file is a summary of academic preparation and work experience that is sent to prospective employers at the student's request. Students have the opportunity to review the contents of the file.

On-Campus Recruiting and Interviews

Employers may come to the campus to recruit students for positions. On-campus interviews may be scheduled for the convenience of employers and students.

Employment Search and Interview

Central Community College prepares students not only to succeed in new careers but also to find that all-important right job after graduation. The Employment Search and Interview course teaches job-seeking skills including:

- ✓ Researching the job market.
- ✓ Writing a resume.
- ✓ Writing a cover letter.
- ✓ Completing applications.
- ✓ Preparing for interviews.
- ✓ Following up on interviews.

Cooperative Education Internship Program

This internship program matches students who have already acquired some skills in their chosen profession with employers who need those skills and, at the same time, can provide students with real-world experience. Internships can be full- or part-time in a paid or unpaid position related to the student's major area of study.

Student Benefits

An internship offers several advantages for CCC students:

- ✓ Apply what you've learned in the classroom while on the job.
- ✓ Gain work experience that will be a valuable addition to your resume.
- ✓ Earn income to help pay for your college expenses.
- ✓ Receive up to 16 semester-hours of college credit through the Cooperative Education program.

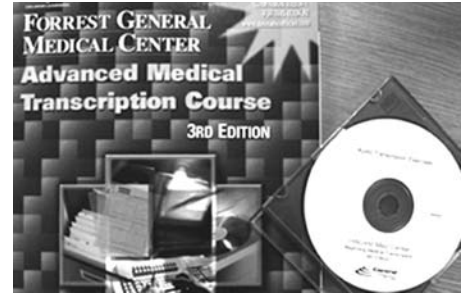
Central Community College students have several avenues open for setting up Cooperative Education internships:

- ✓ If you're just starting a new job, your employer and the college can plan a paid internship that will help you relate what you've learned in the classroom to the demands of your new position.
- ✓ If you've been working at your current job for a while, a Cooperative Education internship can be just the ticket to broaden your job knowledge and increase your value to your employer.
- ✓ If you are enrolled at the college and don't have a job, we can help you find a position related to your major field of study and appropriate for your level of skill.

Employer Advantage

If you are looking for top-notch part-time or full-time employees, consider Central Community College Cooperative Education students.

- ✓ Cooperative Education interns usually have completed at least a semester of study in their major field of interest, so they already have developed basic technical skills. In addition, we can match skill levels to your needs if you want interns who have completed a year or more of course work.
- ✓ Hiring a Cooperative Education student is like hiring any other employee. You interview prospects and decide if they meet your standards. You decide who you hire and how much to pay them.
- ✓ When you hire a CCC Cooperative Education intern, you have an opportunity to meet with the student and a CCC staff member to set job and learning objectives. Employers evaluate interns regularly, and a college representative visits the job site to meet with the employer and evaluate the student's progress toward objectives.
- ✓ Most employers tell us that supervising interns doesn't take any more time than supervising other new employees, and many managers like the Cooperative Education program because it provides specific, measurable training objectives and a system for monitoring employee progress.
- ✓ As a Cooperative Education employer, you can cut down on training costs, identify potential permanent employees, and have an opportunity to evaluate them before making a long-term commitment.

Academic Transfer

Central Community College offers academic transfer programs that are specifically designed to provide the first two years of a four-year degree.

Nebraska Transfer Initiative

CCC is one of the 24 Nebraska colleges that signed the Nebraska Transfer Initiative in November 1995, agreeing to accept a common core of 34 semester-hours of credit completed at any of the colleges.

The Nebraska Transfer Initiative is designed to smooth the transfer process for community college graduates who want to complete a bachelor's degree. Institutions that are members of the Nebraska Transfer Initiative are listed in the chart at the right.

Transfer Agreements

Through specific transfer agreements with individual institutions, students completing associate of arts or associate of science degrees can transfer up to 66 semester-hours of credit earned at Central Community College to many four-year colleges.

Colleges that have provided transfer guides for community colleges are shown in the chart at the right.

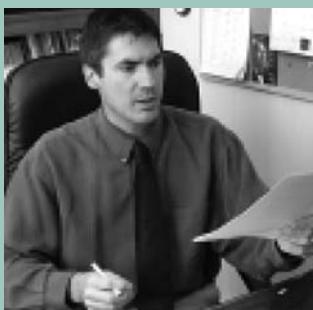
NACRAO Agreement

Central Community College is a signatory of the NACRAO (Nebraska Association of College Registrars and Admissions Officers) Agreement. Students who complete specified liberal arts courses may expect these courses to apply in transfer toward satisfying the general studies program requirements for a degree at other participating Nebraska colleges. Contact the campus admissions office for NACRAO information.

Transfer Outcomes

Academic transfer graduates have transferred successfully to 21 public and private four-year colleges in Nebraska and more than 50 out-of-state colleges.

Follow-up studies show that graduates of Central Community College academic transfer programs are well prepared to continue their education following graduation. Students transferring to the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, as a group, achieve overall grades comparable to other juniors and seniors who attended UN-L for their first two years of college.
